# UK-Malaysia University Consortium Mobility Workshop – Outbound Mobility Overview



#### **Outbound Mobility overview LJMU**

- ✓ 100 students on Study Abroad Exchange 1 or 2 semesters, credit bearing
- √ 60-70 students on global volunteering, 1-12 weeks, not credit bearing
- ✓ 100 students on tailored Summer Schools, 1-4 weeks, not credit bearing
- ✓ 10-15 students on Global internship programme via provider, 8 weeks, not credit bearing
- ✓ 10-20 students on independent work placements, unpaid, 4-8 weeks, not credits
- √ 10-20 students on independent work placements, paid or unpaid, Sandwich year, credit bearing



### UK-Malaysia University Consortium Mobility Workshop – Inbound Mobility Overview



#### **Inbound Mobility overview LJMU**

- √ 100 students on Study Abroad Exchange 1 or 2 semesters, credit bearing
- √ 10-20 students on fee paying Semester Study Abroad, credit/not credit bearing.
- ✓ 30-40 students on International Summer School, 2 weeks, not credit bearing, one pathway (cross-disciplinary)
- $\checkmark$  Virtual winter/summer school, 5-7 days, not credit bearing, two pathways; mini-UN and Design & Media)



## UK-Malaysia University Consortium Mobility Workshop - Turing



#### **What is Turing?**

- ✓ Introduced by UK Government in 2021 in responsive to Brexit and exit from Erasmsus+
- ✓ Guaranteed until 23/24 Academic year
- ✓ 4 Main objectives: Global Britain, Wider Impact, Levelling Up and Value for Taxpayer
- ✓ Student bursaries for Study or Traineeships (incl. volunteering) minimum 4 weeks duration
- ✓ No country/regional priorities
- ✓ No inbound bursaries
- ✓ No staff mobility



# **UK-Malaysia University Consortium Mobility Workshop – Turing Examples**



#### **Examples of LJMU Turing Activities in 2022**

- Tailored Summer schools by selected partners
  - ✓ Helps build strategic long-term partnerships
  - × Subject to uncertain funding and changes in student demand/interests

- 10 students on Internship programme by Third party provider
  - ✓ High calibre placements and value added extras such as networking opportunities
  - × Limited to certain sectors and locations

- Multidisciplinary Student conference in Malaysia Summer '23
- I week duration
- Combined with other UK Outbound activities to allow Turing funding
- Could be combined with online pre-conference sessions and cultural buddy scheme
